

If you filed for Special Immigrant Juvenile Status (SIJS) over the age of 18 in New York . . .

- Did a Family Court in New York appoint a guardian for you when you were older than 18?
- Did you file a form I-360 Petition for Special Immigrant when you were older than 18?
- If so, you may have applied for SIJS.

In March 2019, a federal judge in NY found that the U.S. government (USCIS) incorrectly denied applications of SIJS eligible youth over the age of 18 in NY.

If you filed a SIJS application over the age of 18 and since January 2016, 1) your application was denied or 2) your SIJS was taken away by USCIS or 3) USCIS told you that your application would be denied, or 4) your case is still pending before USCIS, you may be affected by the judge's order.
